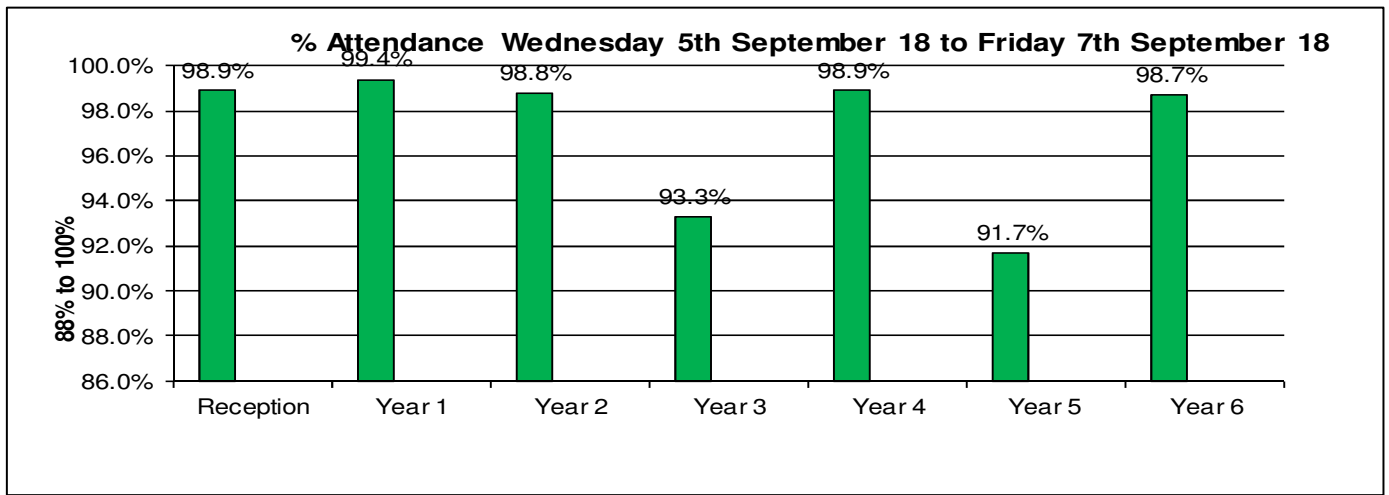
We do hope to see you there.
