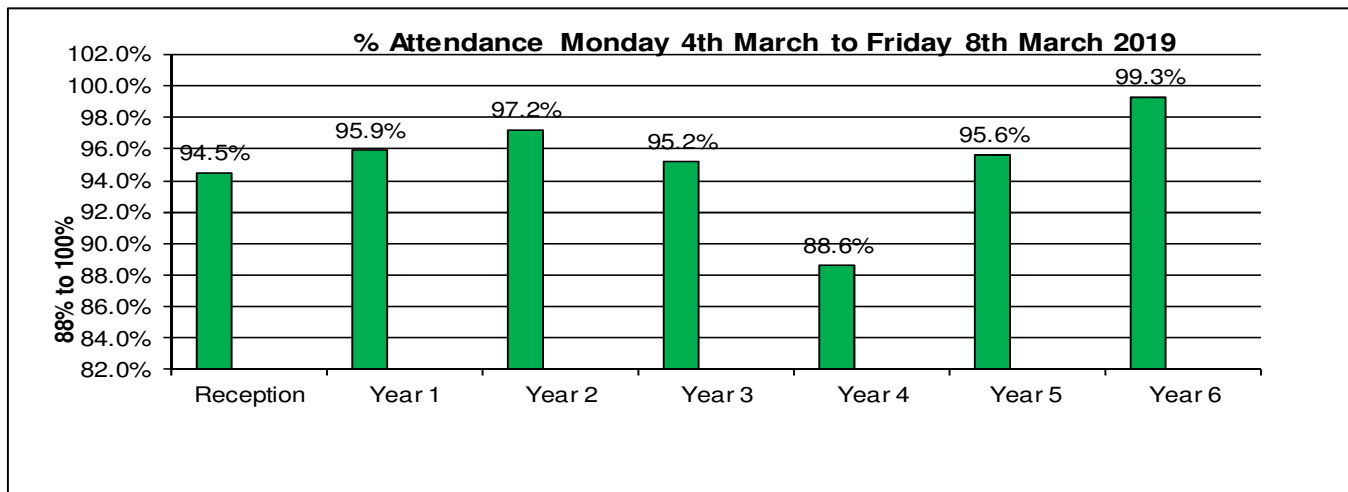
## PTA Meeting
