The Great Egg Race!

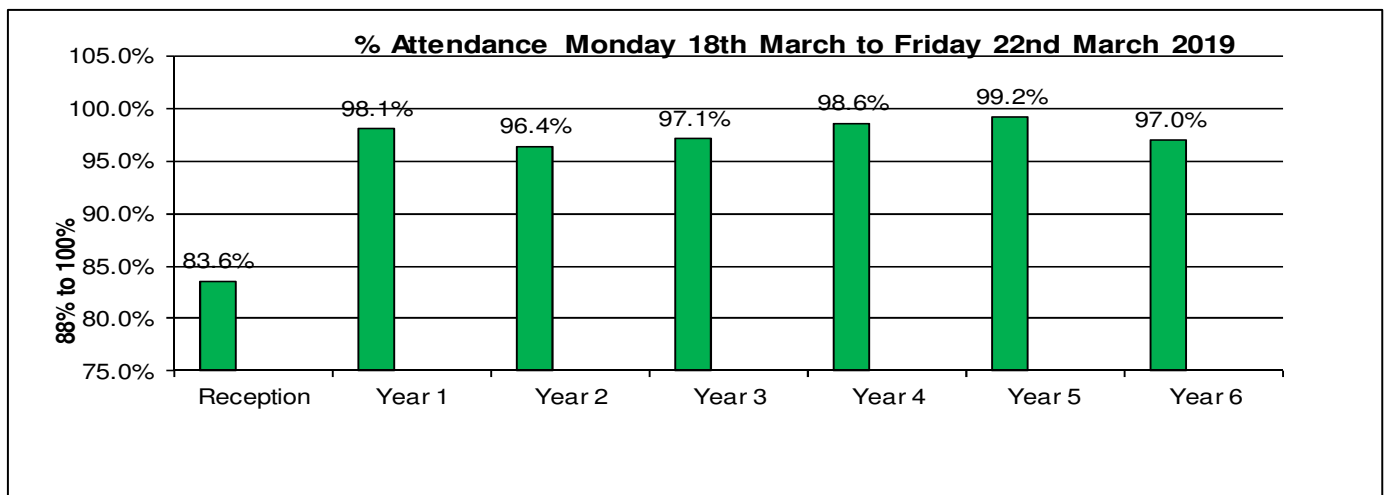
The 'Great Egg Race' for children in Year 3 to Year 6 will take place on Friday 12th April. A leaflet with full details was sent home earlier this week.
