We look forward to seeing you.

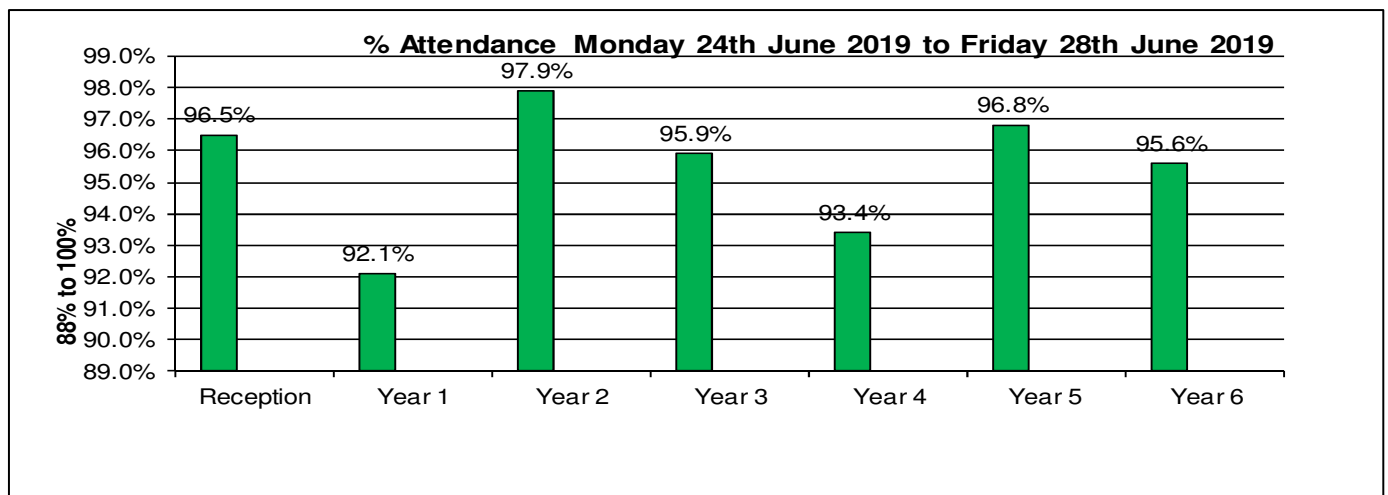


## Share A Story - Tuesday 9th July to Friday 12th July 2019
