Here are just a few of the jars.



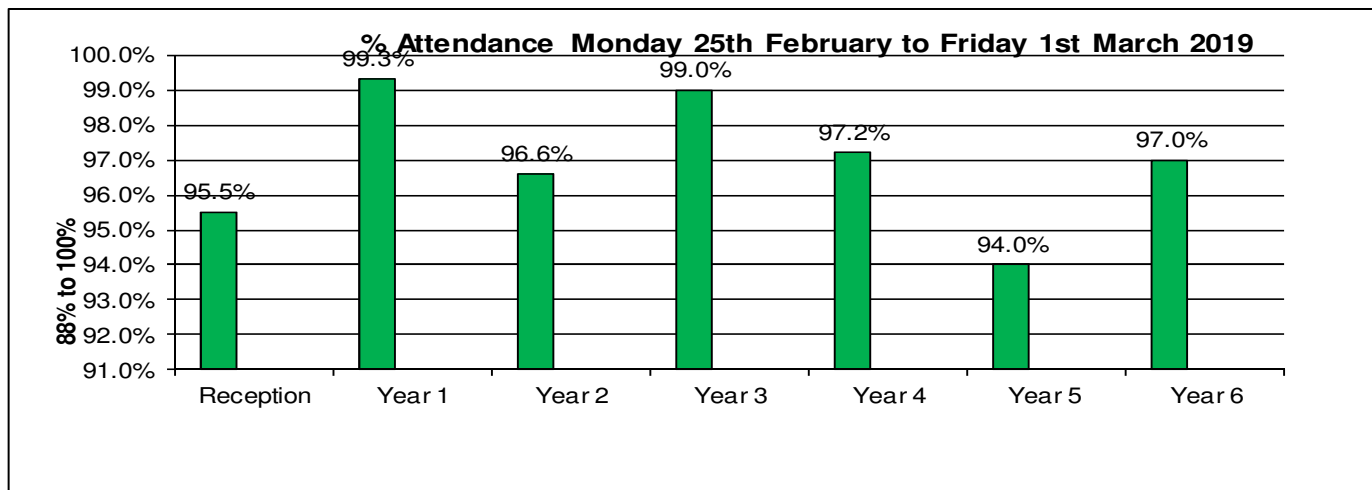
Golden Top Table

On Monday 25th March Whoberley will be holding an Eco-Day for the whole school. All of the children will spend the day learning about recycling and caring for our environment as well as getting to do



some planting around the school grounds. We have an Eco-Team who are very enthusiastic about making our school more Eco friendly and have already been putting ideas together in order to apply for an Eco-Schools Award. Our Eco-Day will help us kick start the project and get our school allotment up and running. If any parents or carers are interested in being involved in the committee and helping to make our school an Eco-School Award winner please let us know.

Some of the activities planned will involve using a range of recycled materials to create different things. To help us with our project we are collecting used plastic bottles of different shapes, colours and sizes and circular shaped lids from containers (for example, plastic bottle tops, jar lids, gravy powder lids, washing up liquid tops) - the brighter, the better. If you use any of these over the next few weeks please give them a rinse and send them into school for our collection instead of putting them in the bin. Thank you for your continued support.
